

# PLAY, *The Retreat*

JANUARY 27-31, 2011 ~ PORT TOWNSEND, WA

This winter, come join us as we cozy into our creating space for 3 full days and four evenings of art making. The retreat will be like a mini artists residency, where each artist will bring their favorite mediums to the fort to work on...and to share. We will expect each participant to take about 10 minutes at some point during the weekend to do a brief demo of a cool technique they know or talk about their work and how they do it. In this way, we will benefit from a wide variety of styles, ideas and tips. But PLAY will remain what we all love the most. Just long periods of time to work on what we love and explore new possibilities with our favorite mediums. As a sidenote...you do not need to present if that is something out of your comfort zone.

Unlike actual artists' residencies, you need not pre-qualify to attend. Sometimes it can be the new artists who have great fresh new ideas, so whatever your level is, you are welcome. Groups like this are so great for collaborating too. Bring your work and invite suggestions from your fellow artists. Sometimes a fresh pair of eyes can really open your own, especially if you feel that your work has been getting a little stale and don't know which direction to go next.

Tracy and I will once again bring our large paper cutter, tear bar, journaling pens, stencils and airbrush system, toaster oven and anything else we feel might be useful. Each person will get their own 6' table to work on in addition to having a circle of chairs (and one table to demo at) in a separate area for each of your presentations.

There is an excellent art store in town ([www.akamaiart.com](http://www.akamaiart.com)) should you forget anything or want to play around with something new.
