

# ARTFEST April 6-10, 2011

## WELCOME

This will be our 12th anniversary of doing Artfest at Fort Worden and attendees continue to say that it just gets better and better every year! We are excited to welcome back many previous teachers who we love & adore as well as a bunch of new teachers who promise even more unique projects & techniques. While our workshops are incredible, it is our extracurricular events, the location and the attendees who come that sets Artfest apart from other events. People leave with brand new friendships that last for years, new groups that they stay involved with long after the event is over, a renewed sense of their artistic selves and a recharged battery to take back with them to their normal lives. It is a very nourishing event for your creative selves. There is magic that happens in Port Townsend during the event that no one can explain, but everyone feels.

The workshops are full day, 6 hour sessions (with a 90 minute lunch break) designed to provide not only several techniques learned throughout the day but time enough to actually work on what has been learned so that it can sink in and a nice chunk in the middle of the day to renew yourself. The teachers come from all over the United States, Canada & Australia and represent some of the best in their fields.

We offer an exciting artist's marketplace on Friday night, providing a rare opportunity to buy original artwork from many of the best alternative artists around the country. You can find everything from found art jewelry, to assemblage art, mixed media paintings, handmade charms, purses, prints, hand-bound journals, funky zines, art dolls, textile artwork, and various other one-of-a-kind works for sale. This is an exciting time to pick up original work that sells for much higher prices in galleries and such.

On Saturday night we have our show-n-tell where we invite all attendees to bring what they have made during their workshops so we can all see who made what and in which class. Many have said this was among their favorite events at Artfest.

Thursday is the night that we encourage smaller gatherings to take place. Groups start to form within officer's houses & dorm wings as attendees meet to discuss the day's events and projects. Other online groups use this evening to meet face to face and exchange projects they may have been working on (in the months leading up to artfest) and we always host a journaling party down on the beach with a bonfire and s'more fixin's for you to enjoy. In 2011, we will continue the extremely popular Iron Chef Artist challenge that we debuted in 2010. All in all, there's something for everyone's mood that evening.

In addition, we offer a gallery so that the attendees can create works of art that can be for sale....or not for sale. We do this to allow the attendees an opportunity to make a few bucks to supplement their expenses. This is always an inspiring show that everyone loves. You can submit up to 3 pieces. No jury. More details will come in your confirmation packet.

## LOCATION

Fort Worden is an old military base that is located in beautiful Port Townsend, Washington. In fact, it is SO delightful, that we have had several persons decide to move there after attending

Artfest! Even though the fort is a little rough around the edges, Artfest attendees continually tell us that is what adds to its charm. You will see deer casually walking right in front of you as you meander down to your workshops. With the ocean and the trees as your backdrop, it will take your breath away. It is approximately a 2-hour drive from the SeaTac Airport. The trip involves driving into Seattle, taking a 1/2 hour ferry to Bainbridge Island and then traveling for about an hour North up the other side of Puget Sound. Most folks get together (via the Yahoo chat group) and share a rental car but we do offer a shuttle from the airport (for about \$80 RT) for those who need it. It has only one pick up time from the airport (2pm) and one departure time back to the airport (8am). More details will be in your confirmation packet.

## REGISTRATION

To make it into this very popular event, it is super important to mail in your form BY or BEFORE Sept. 3rd (a Friday) as we fill almost to capacity on the first day. But chances are great that if you send it in by that day, you will make it in. **You may send in your forms anytime from the moment the website is up. However, we will not process anything until the 4th of September.** Confirmation packets start going out around the 20th of September.

## PRICING

For 3 days of workshops, 4 nights of lodging, goodies and all the extra events:

off campus - \$490 (choose your own lodging in Port Townsend)  
private room in any dorm - \$590  
shared room in dorm 225 - \$570  
shared room in dorm 202 or 203 - \$550  
shared room in officers housing - \$610  
private room in officers housing - \$760

A deposit of \$300 is required with your form to register. The 2nd half is due by Jan. 5, 2011. Please see the registration form for our cancellation policy.

## DESCRIPTION OF ACCOMMODATIONS:

These are old buildings built around the turn of the century. The fort has been on a path of fixing and updating many of its accommodations for the past few years and every year we see much improvement! Still, if you think of this as going to camp, you'll be fine. If, however, you are accustomed to the best hotels, we would strongly suggest getting the off-campus option.

**OFF CAMPUS** - This option is good for folks who live close to the retreat, prefer nicer accommodations, or prefer their own room with their own bathroom. Port Townsend has a gazillion B&B's available in their Victorian town. There are some average motels in town as well. You can do a search on Google for options.

**DORMS** - These buildings have very small single rooms with communal bathrooms down the hall. 2 of the dorms have communal showers but we procure extra bathrooms/showers upstairs and post sign-up sheets so everyone can have privacy while showering. We also use the men's restrooms as well to provide even more space for the women. For this reason, we

do not allow men in the dorms. Linens, pillow, blanket, towels, etc. are included with each room. But some folks like to bring their own pillow and an extra blanket. Make no doubt about it, these are bare bones rooms but we have people request them every year. If you request to **share a dorm** room, this year we have separated the dorms into 2 price categories. Dorm 225 has 2 twin beds in each shared room while dorm 202 & 203 involves 2-5 beds in one room. Most of these rooms (in 202) have dividers between the beds to provide a little privacy.

**OFFICERS HOUSES** - These houses range from 2 bedroom units to 11 bedroom units. They were built for the first officers installed at Fort Worden and many have their original features including ornate tin ceilings and fireplaces. Each house has a kitchen equipped with toaster, coffee maker, fridge, oven, pans, dishes and utensils. The houses have a great living room that is perfect for spreading out what you've made during the day and sharing with your housemates. They are large with lots of space. All the rooms have one queen bed in each, so if you pick the shared option, you will be sharing a bed. We have **very few** rooms that we can set aside for "private"-(one person in a room). For this reason, we strongly suggest that you provide a 2nd choice of accommodations if you choose this as your first (or pick off campus if privacy is an issue).

**Staying in the dorms or one of the houses provides a unique experience that helps make Artfest what it is. Folks usually have show and tell each night in their house or dorm and make friends which last long after the retreat is over.**

### RESERVING HOUSING

If you have a group who would like to share a house or a dorm room or wing, please contact us in august with how many people you have. We will try to set a certain space aside for your group so you can all be together. However there are some rules. Everyone **MUST** send in their registrations by the opening day of registration. We cannot hold anything for you if you don't. We can not make any promises. And, if one or more of your group cancels, we have every right to fill that empty space with a person of our choosing. You will have the option of first finding a replacement person for the one cancelling but if that does not happen within 2 weeks, we will fill the space ourselves. Include the name of your group (name of the organizer). We will email you back with choices.

### Meals

are optional. They are served buffet style. Many attendees love mealtimes as it allows time to get to know their fellow artists better. They specialize in local, mostly organic fare and the raves from our attendees last year were loud and clear. They always provide a good selection of entrees & sides, a salad bar and a selection of desserts along with a soda fountain. We can offer a vegetarian option only (no vegan, no gluten-free, no fish-only, etc). You may add any combination of the following to your registration:

4 breakfasts (thur, fri, sat, sun) - \$50

3 lunches (thur, fri, sat) - \$40

4 dinners (wed, thur, fri, sat) - \$70
